Important Information for Spring 2021 Swimming Lessons

Registration / Payment:

- If you elected to have a voucher on your account (i.e., “credit” for last spring’s lessons) and you have not yet used that credit for another Community Ed activity, the voucher will be applied automatically when you register for swim lessons.
- If you have used your voucher, you will need to enter payment, just as you would for any other class.
- If you still have a voucher and do not want to take swim lessons at this time, you may either keep the voucher on your account for a future Community Ed class or contact us if you would like a refund at this time (email delanocommunityed@delanoschools.org or call 763-972-6210, press 3).

Spring Lesson Schedules:

- Thursday session: 7 Thursdays, April 8 – May 20
- Saturday session: 7 Saturdays, April 10 – May 22

Registration for spring lessons will open on: Thursday, March 25 at 4:00 PM. The lesson times can be found at the bottom of this document.

Capacity: Due to physical distancing requirements, we will only be able to hold three classes in each time slot. Each class will be required to maintain six feet of social distancing during swim lessons.

Procedural Changes

Parents in the Water for Preschool A through Level 2 Classes:

Due to the fact that our teachers must remain socially distanced from the students, a parent / guardian will be required to be in the water with all preschool level classes and with levels 1. For level 2, we will require a parent in the water for the first day and possibly the second day while the teacher evaluates your child’s comfort level. The teacher will provide you with direction for the remainder of the class days. **There will be no exceptions allowed.**

The only classes that will not require an adult in the water with the student will be levels 3-6.

No “spectators” during lessons:

The only people allowed in the pool during lessons will be the students and the parent who will be in the water with them. No additional adults or additional children will be allowed.

One parent / guardian of Level 3, 4, 5, and 6 students may accompany their child into the building to check in with the staff. You then either need to leave the building or you may wait in the media center. If you wait in the media center, you must remain socially distanced from other parents and you must keep your mask on at all times. If you leave the building, please return promptly at the end of the lesson time. Your child will exit through door #5 and come out to your vehicle.

Lesson length:

Aquatots and Tadpoles classes are 30 minutes. Preschool levels and Learn-to-Swim levels 1-6 are 40 minutes long.

There will be a ten-minute break between most of the classes to allow staff to perform additional cleaning required by COVID procedures.

The sessions will be seven weeks, rather than eight weeks, due to the remaining time in the school year. The safety components covered during the final week will be incorporated throughout the other weeks. Your child will receive all the scheduled curriculum for their level.

Masks / face shields:

Masks are required for everyone except children 5 and under at all times when you are in the building, except when you are actually in the water during lessons. If your child is in Kindergarten (and age 5), please have them wear a mask, consistent with expectations for all Kindergarten students. Once you exit the water, you must put your mask on immediately. Parents may opt to wear face shields (provide your own) when you are in the water if you want.

Social distancing:

While in the building and in the pool, you must maintain six feet of distance between members of your household and other people.

Symptom Checker:

Parents must review the COVID-19 symptom checker for both the students and the parent / guardian prior to attending lessons each week. If the student, parent / guardian, or a member of the household is exhibiting any of the symptoms, they must stay home. If your household is in quarantine, you must stay home. If the child, parent / guardian, or any member of the household tests positive for COVID-19, you must immediately notify Community Education.

Locker room use:

We ask that both parents and students arrive with their swim suit already on underneath your clothes.

You will not be allowed to leave anything in the locker room during lessons. In fact, there will be “one-way” traffic flow, so that you will leave through a different locker room than you use when you arrive.

Please bring a bag to put your clothes / towels in during lessons.

Arriving / Departing from Lessons:

- Enter the building through Door 5 - which is the door by the loading dock - the long sidewalk that runs alongside the west wall of the pool.
- Please put your jackets, etc. in the hallway as directed by staff.
- Follow signs to the family locker room.
- Maintain social distancing of six feet from other families in the locker room.
- Get undressed and take a shower prior to entering the pool deck (shower required).
- Please put your clothes and towels in your bag and take it with you into the pool area. You may NOT leave anything in the locker room.
- Enter the pool and put your bag on the bleachers on one of the Xs.
- The instructors will direct you to the area for your lesson.
- When the lesson is over, you will exit the pool, having put your mask on once you are out of the water.

- You will leave through the “regular” girls / boys locker room - simply get dressed and leave. You must maintain 6 feet social distancing in the locker room and keep your mask on at all times. Please do not linger / visit with others while in the locker room or hallway.
- Retrieve your coats from the hallway.
- Leave the building through door 5.

Lesson start times are staggered when possible to help prevent congestion as people arrive and depart.
